Thanks for your e-mail that Roy Newton has passed on to me for a response. The comments will be taken on board for full submission of LTP2.

Firstly, it was extremely unfortunate for the website to malfunction so badly during a critical consultation period, but unfortunately it was out of the teams hands for a week whilst servers and telephone exchanges were corrected.

I am slightly concerned that you didn't receive the hard copy through the post when you requested one. This could be a problem as the leaflet was produced by ourselves in the Joint Transport Team, rather than the PTE themselves. I will attempt to rectify the problem in future by ensuring that the PTE are fully aware of this type of initiative and let us know of any requests.

PTE distribution however did deliver the document around Greater Manchester- into libraries, sports centres, bus stations, rail stations and council offices and information points- this was backed up by advertorials and press releases in the local press to raise awareness. I would hope it was nothing more bad luck and a better take up than expected that meant they had temporarily run out of them at Longsight library when you called, but will check with the distribution team that this is the case and they are not missing them out from deliveries. Thanks for putting 50 copies in Longsight library, much appreciated.

You may be interested to know that we are collating all responses made in the consultation process relating to LTP2 policy into a report, and responding to them point by point. This will be included as an annexe to the main document in the full submission.
