Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to request the installation of a street sign at the junction of Hamilton Road and Mentor Street in Longsight.

Although Mentor Street has 'no entry' signs at the end where it joins Slade Lane to indicate that drivers cannot exit onto Slade Lane, and is therefore in effect a no through road, there is nothing to indicate this at the Hamilton Road end. It has been brought to my attention when speaking with other local residents that this is causing a dangerous situation at busy times. Cars turn up this road with the intention of joining Slade Lane and then find themselves having to turn around in a road that, because of parked cars, is too narrow. The problem of on-road parking is another issue which needs urgent redress, but this does not mean that a road sign cannot be installed to indicate that this road is a no through way, therefore making it less likely that cars will be driven up there in the expectation of being able to join Slade Lane. The current situation is dangerous for all road users and is particularly worrying because it is close to a school.
